

Clinical Fellowship of Urogynecology in Japan

The Urogynecology Center of Kameda Medical Center is a famous leading center for urogynecology field in Japan. Our service does not only involve patients' care but we are also very keen in training and research. We have initiated an International Clinical Fellowship program for Urogynecology since 2013. We recruit an international fellow who is interested in training of laparoscopic and transvaginal surgery. An international fellow has officially hand-on training for both transvaginal and laparoscopic surgery under the license of the Minister of Health, Labor and Welfare in Japan. We have more than 500 surgeries (350 transvaginal and 150 laparoscopic surgery) in urogynecology field in a year. An international fellow can learn latest surgical techniques for transvaginal sling and mesh surgery and laparoscopic sacrocolpopexy.

Period of Fellowship program: One year

Contents

Hands-on training in performing various important urogynecology procedure which include:

- 1. Vaginal mesh surgery and native tissue repair for pelvic organ prolapse
- 2. Laparoscopic sacrocolpopexy
- 3. Tension-free vaginal tape (TVT), transobturator tape (TOT)
- 4. Vaginal hysterectomy, laparoscopic total and subtotal hysterectomy
- 5. Cystoscopy, hydrodistention for interstitial cystitis

Hands-on training in performing important urogynecology procedures which include:

- 1. Urodynamic study
- 2. Translabial/perineal ultrasound
- 3. Endoanal ultrasound

Research and publication

Fellows are given the opportunity to conduct a clinical research, and will be guided on writing research paper aiming for publication in a peer-reviewed journal.

Certificate

Fellows will be awarded a Certificate of Fellowship in Urogynecology upon completion of the program.

Salary

No salary offered. However accommodation (a fully furnished apartment) is provided with utility expenses are covered.
