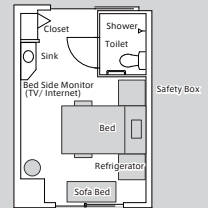
Almost all of the rooms have a spectacular Pacific Ocean view, and the room size is 21㎡. Each room is complete with a bed side monitor which contains internet, TV, and access to your medical record (if desired). The headboard with designer fabric inlay hides the medical gas, emergency electricity outlets, and vacuum ports. There is a sink in every room as well as a private toilet and shower. The bed side monitor, as previously described, is installed in every room as well as a sofa bed for an overnight guest or visitor.

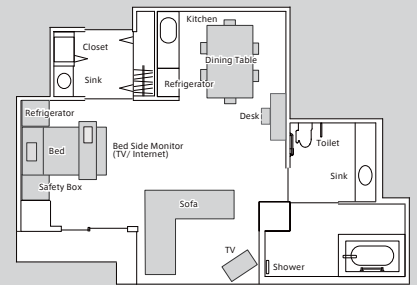

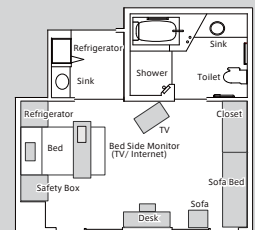

- You can watch TV, use the Internet and see your Electronic Medical Record using "PLANET" with the bed side monitor placed in your room. If you want to use "PLANET", you are required to register for it in advance.
- We have devoted 2 floors (4th & 5th floor) of the K-Tower exclusively for Women.
- If you don't have any food restriction, you can choose from other menus with an extra charge.
- If your visitors would like to have lunch or dinner with you in your room, please order "room service".
- Specially approved visitors such as family members can be permitted 24 hours a day by patients hospitalized in the K-Tower.
- There is a sofa bed for a patient's family to be able to stay with him/her overnight.
- Concierge service supports the patient's comfortable hospital stay.
- If you are planning to use any personal electronic devices, please note that Japan's electricity is 50Hz and 105V, but most modern electrical devices can accommodate this difference.
- If you have a three prong connector, you may need an adapter that converts it to the more common two prong connector for use in most electrical outlets in Japan. An electrical transformer is usually not needed.
